Canada Summer Research Opportunities Programme (SROP) (Not the same as the <i>Research Opportunity Program (ROP) at UTM, see below</i>)	A highly competitive, immersive, 8-week professional development programme held during the summer. Involves working on a research project, as well as a professional development course focused on preparation of graduate school applications. Students will receive a stipend for the 8-week period.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify as Black, Indigenous, or Person of Colour (BIPOC) and want to apply to grad school Can be from any university (not just U of T) Should be at least halfway through undergrad program 	Around February	https://canadasrop.ca/
UTM Research Opportunities Program (ROP)	Provides students in second to fourth year with the chance to participate in the research of a faculty member while earning course credit. For Summer ROP, we ask for a 16-20 hour per week commitment. For Fall-Winter: 8-10 hours/week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open to UTM students See this document for which ROP course number you should apply for 	Usually around early March (Projects posted in February for both summer and the following academic year)	Link here We typically post projects open to second through fourth year students
NSERC Undergraduate Student Research Award (USRA)	Summer research project for 16 weeks with <i>full-time</i> commitment and a stipend awarded to you. Please note that this is a very competitive program, and selection is primarily based on GPA.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Canadian citizens or permanent residents UTM students given preference Priority given to students in summer between 3rd & 4th year Priority given to highest GPAs 	Usually around mid-March	Link here If you're interested in proposing a project, please reach out to us
Independent Research Project (IRP) or Thesis	For advanced students looking to complete an independent research project under our supervision & receive course credit (8-12+ hour per week commitment)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Thesis: UTM students in 4th year (See Thesis requirements here) IRP: UTM 3rd and 4th year students (see details here) We give priority to students who have <i>previous lab experience</i> (either in our lab or related areas of cognitive psych) If you don't have experience, but need an IRP for specialist program requirements, contact us about doing a literature review IRP 	For Thesis: usually around the end of April For IRP: enrol by first week of classes, but we prefer that you reach out to us well in advance	Thesis link ; IRP link If you're interested in IRP or Thesis, <u>please reach out to us well in advance.</u>
